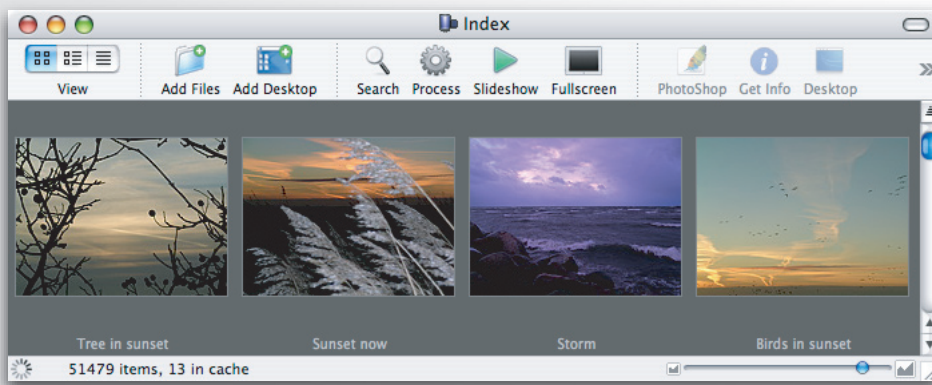

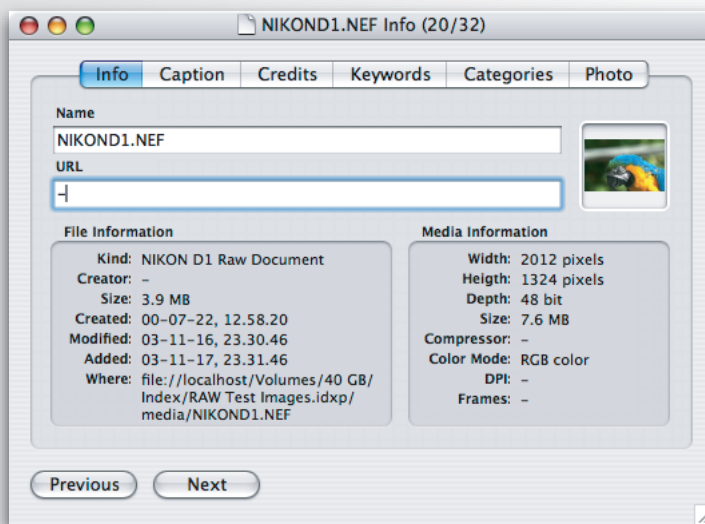

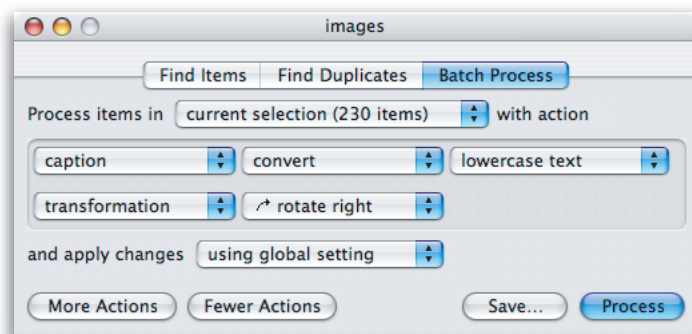


Annotations
